Faye Anderson is a public policy consultant who works with nonprofits and community-based organizations on a wide range of issues, including historic preservation, zoning, planning and development, and public art.

Faye is founder and director of All That Philly Jazz, a place-based public history project that is documenting Philadelphia's golden age of jazz. The project is at the intersection of public policy, cultural heritage preservation and community engagement. She successfully nominated the John Coltrane House, a National

nominated the John Coltrane House, a National Historic Landmark, for listing on 2020 Pennsylvania At Risk.

Faye's work as a preservationist has been recognized by the National Trust for Historic Preservation, and she was profiled by the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. A freelance journalist, Faye's writing has appeared in the New York Times, Washington Post, Wall Street Journal, Philadelphia Inquirer, and other publications.
